

## Objective Descriptive Essay Examples

Our living room is painted white. Also the door is white with glass in it. On the left hand side there is a dark wooden dining table with four seats around: They are made of plastic. Two of them are yellow and two of them are blue. On the table there are two empty wine bottles which are used as candleholders.

Beside the table there are three blue armchairs placed in a semicircle. In the middle of this semicircle there is a black table with four candles, a packet of cookies and two ashtrays on it.
